I.O.NOTE / MEMORANDUM

Sub:- Clearance in respect of Government servants for obtaining 'No Objection Certificate' for Passport.

Ref:- U.O.Note/Memorandum No.3-6/85-CVO dt. 7-8-1985 of Chief Vigilance Office.

Instructions have been issued under para. 2.1 of the U.O.Note/Memorandum cited, to the effect that for obtaining 'No Objection Certificate', in connection with issuing passports, the Inspector General of Police has to be addressed for according clearance from security angle in respect of the Applicant.

2. It is, however, noticed that, as per the procedure adopted at present, any Government servant applying for Passport has to submit applications alongwith 'No Objection Certificate' and a verification certificate signed by the Head of Department in the official stationery and that such applications are exempted from the requirement of Police Verification, prior to issue of Passport and also that in case such applications are not approved by the Verification Certificate of the Head of Department, then only such applications will require Police Verification report, prior to issue of Passport.

3. In view of the above, and after careful consideration, it has been decided that the following procedure may be adopted in partial modification of the procedure mentioned at para. 2.1 in the U.O.Note/Memorandum cited.

- i) As soon as a request for issue of 'No Objection Certificate' from a Government Servant is received, the concerned Head of Department will address the Chief Vigilance Office, direct, along with the prescribed particulars for obtaining vigilance clearance. Simultaneously, a Verification Certificate, as signed by the Head of Department in the official stationery, be also issued which will enable the issue of passport without any Police Verification before issue of passport. The present procedure of addressing hence the Inspector General of Police, for obtaining clearance from security angle at the time of issuing No Objection Certificate is dispensed with immediately.

ii) All the other instructions contained in the U.O.Note/Memorandum will remain unaltered.

4. The Heads of Departments are requested to adhere to the above revised instructions while processing request for issue of 'No Objection Certificate' for obtaining Passport, in future.
